Dear Sir or Madam,

On behalf of the United States District Court-District of Minnesota, I am writing to inform you that your name was placed on our 2010-2011 Master Jury Wheels. Each year the Court creates new Master Jury Wheels from which we determine who may be qualified to serve as one of our jurors. Only a portion of the persons whose names are placed on a Master Jury Wheel will be asked to report to the courthouse to serve as jurors between September 1, 2010 and August 31, 2011.

All persons identified on the Master Jury Wheel are required by federal law to complete a Juror Qualification Questionnaire and return it within ten days of receipt. You can either complete and sign the enclosed questionnaire form or log onto our website (www.mnd.uscourts.gov) to complete the form online using eJuror. See the enclosed flyer for more information regarding eJuror. I encourage you to give the questionnaire the due consideration it deserves.

Also enclosed with this letter is a Jury Qualification Questionnaire Frequently Asked Questions form, which should answer most of your questions at this time. For additional information, you may also visit our court's website at www.mnd.uscourts.gov or call the jury clerks at the numbers listed above.

Thank you in advance for filling out the Jury Qualification Questionnaire. The judicial system in our country relies on the willingness of its citizens to serve as jurors. We understand that serving as a juror may be disruptive to your everyday activities and livelihood. Should you be asked to serve as a juror, we pledge our best efforts to treat you and your time with respect and dignity.

We look forward to receiving your questionnaire and possibly having you serve as a juror in our Court.
