Plaintiff Carol Davis, individually and as the Administratrix of the Estate of Gilbert F. Freedlander, by and through her counsel, filed a Notice of Voluntary Dismissal With Prejudice on January 4, 2008 (MDL No. 05-1708 (DWF/AJB), Doc. No. 2537; Civil No. 07-2330 (DWF/AJB), Doc. No. 3), pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1) with respect to her claims against Defendants Guidant Corporation, Guidant Sales Corporation, Cardiac Pacemakers Inc., and Boston Scientific Corporation. 1. Plaintiff Carol Davis, individually and as the Administratrix of the Estate of Gilbert F. Freedlander's claims against Defendants Guidant Corporation, Guidant Sales Corporation, Cardiac Pacemakers Inc., and Boston Scientific Corporation expressed in the Complaint (Civil No. 07-2330 (DWF/AJB), Doc. No. 1) are **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**.
