
Background and Facts:

1. The Mulligan Law Firm filed for Kenneth Pruett, Civil No. 07-cv-1217, under the mistaken belief that Kenneth Pruett was a Mulligan Law Firm client.
2. The Mulligan Law Firm had received other paperwork from Kenneth Pruett but never received an executed contract.
3. When the oversight was uncovered, the Mulligan Law Firm filed an amended petition in July of 2007 requesting that the court dismiss Kenneth Pruett's case.
4. The court has asked the Mulligan Law Firm to dismiss with prejudice.

5. The Mulligan Law Firm cannot dismiss with prejudice because the Mulligan Law Firm does not represent Kenneth Pruett.

We therefore ask the court:

1. To allow the Mulligan Law Firm to withdraw as counsel for Kenneth Pruett in Civil No. 07-cv-1217.
2. To remove Kenneth Pruett from the Mulligan Law Firm's list of clients for the proposed settlement.
