Plaintiffs John Clark and Shirley Clark, by and through their counsel, and Defendants Guidant Corporation, Guidant Sales Corporation, Cardiac Pacemakers Inc., and Boston Scientific Corporation, by and through their counsel, filed a Stipulation of Dismissal With Prejudice (MDL No. 05-1708 (DWF/AJB), Doc. Nos. 2550 and 2551; Civil No. 07-3342 (DWF/AJB), Doc. Nos. 3 and 4) in the above-referenced matter, pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1).
