**ORDER REGARDING MOTIONS TO  
RECONSIDER THE COURT'S  
ORDER REGARDING  
DETERMINATION OF THE  
COMMON BENEFIT ATTORNEY  
FEE AMOUNT**

On February 15, 2008, the Court filed its Order Regarding Determination of the Common Benefit Attorney Fee Amount. (MDL 05-1708 (DWF/AJB), Doc. No. 2603.) In the February 15, 2008 Short Order, the Court indicated that a Memorandum Opinion and Order would follow. It has come to the Court's attention that certain Plaintiffs' counsel may seek permission to file a Motion to Reconsider. The Court, however, will not consider any such request until after the Memorandum Opinion and Order is filed. Therefore, the Court instructs all parties to wait until after the Court's Memorandum Opinion and Order is filed to submit such a request.

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that:

1. Parties shall not seek permission to file a Motion to Reconsider the February 15, 2008 Order until after the Court issues its Memorandum Opinion and Order addressing the February 15, 2008 Order.
