I am a litigant involved in this case represented by the LOCKS LAW FIRM. I would like to voice some concern with the progress of the distribution. According to the facts given to me by my lawyer, Andrew Bell, during these proceedings, the slow wheels of justice are an act of the Court. The settlement was agreed upon July 2007. I was informed an amount would be determined October 2007 and distributed by January 2008. During this period of time, how many clients have died? I was just given some pretty scary news recently myself. Part of the amount of my settlement is because of lost wages from 7 years ago. I am presently unemployed and would greatly appreciate the opportunity of leaving my family with some financial stability. Much water goes under the bridge in 2 ½ years and it is washing away my families future. Also, it should be known that I have no liability to Medicare, Medicaid, Workers Compensation etc. I am informed that the delay of distribution is partially because of these issues.
