**ORDER ALLOCATING CY PRES  
FUNDS**

The Judicial Panel on Multi District Litigation transferred this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §1407 to the District of Minnesota before the Honorable James M. Rosenbaum (ret.). This Court appointed Dan Gustafson of Gustafson Gluek and Charles S. Zimmerman of Zimmerman Reed as co-lead counsel.

Ultimately, the parties reached a global settlement of all claims pending before this Court, including the reimbursement of all costs and expenses advanced by the Plaintiffs’ Steering Committee as well as the payment of attorneys’ fees to the Plaintiffs’ Steering Committee. Co-lead counsel has informed the Court that after the distribution of all funds appropriately due to claimants and to counsel, \$60,646.13 remains in the MDL trust account maintained by Zimmerman Reed in an IOLTA account at BMO Harris Bank. Based upon this information, the Court finds that a portion of these funds are appropriate for cy pres distribution.

The Court hereby orders that fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) shall be awarded

to the Washburn Center for Children as a cy pres beneficiary. Co-lead counsel shall pay this amount to Washburn Center for Children within 5 days of this Order.
