**ORDER TO VACATE ORDER FOR REASSIGNMENT AND REINSTATE
THE CLAIMS OF PLAINTIFF WANDA WALKER TO MDL NO. 1726**

Before this Court is the stipulation of Plaintiff Wanda Walker and Defendant Medtronic, Inc. The Court finds that Plaintiff Wanda Walker's case was inadvertently included in the April 23, 2007 Amended Order, Appendix A [Dkt. Entry #7/MDL Dkt. Entry #496] and Plaintiff's claims were severed and reassigned in error. The Court therefore VACATES THE ORDER FOR REASSIGNMENT, as it relates to PLAINTIFF WANDA WALKER'S CASE from MDL 1726. The Court further ORDERS REINSTATEMENT of PLAINTIFF WANDA WALKER'S CASE related to the Micro Jewel II Model 7223Cx, Serial No. PFR105577H, in MDL 1726.
