**ORDER REGARDING  
NON-EIF RECOMMENDATIONS  
AND SETTING DEADLINE TO  
OBJECT TO RECOMMENDATIONS**

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The Claims Review Committee will submit its recommendations on the base allocation awards for Claimants that did not seek Extraordinary Injury Fund (“EIF”) awards to the Court no later than March 14, 2008. By that same date, the Claims Review Committee shall provide counsel for each Claimant notice of the recommended amount of these base allocations by email notification. Claimants shall have until March 21, 2008 to file written objections to the recommended base allocations which shall clearly explain the basis for the objection and shall attach the relevant documentation from the record. Claimant shall highlight or otherwise specify the portions of the record that support the objection. The objections and attachments shall not exceed ten pages. These objections should be filed electronically with the Court in the above-captioned matter.

The Court will schedule a hearing on any objections if necessary after review of the filed objections.
