4.2 Fees	Event titled, <i>Application to Proceed in Forma Pauperis in District Court</i> modified to <i>Application to Proceed in District Court Without Prepaying Fees or Costs</i> to match the Local Rule language
6.1 Continuance	<i>Motion to Continue</i> events for civil and criminal were modified to <i>Motion for Continuance</i> to match the Local Rule language
7.1(a) Meet-and-Confer	New event created to file the <i>Meet & Confer Statement</i> , located under Supporting Documents & Responses . New Meet & Confer Statement form has been created, and is located under Court Forms.
LR 7.1(c) Dispositive Motions	A new menu item was created for letter events. A new letter event, <i>Letter to Request Scheduling of a Hearing on a Dispositive Motion</i> was created to request a hearing date under LR 7.1(c)(5)(B) The <i>Notice of Hearing on Motion</i> event was modified with a prompt to select if no hearing was scheduled; the event will populate that the hearing is set at a date and time to be determined. Notice of Hearing form has been amended to accommodate circumstances when an attorney does not receive a hearing date. The <i>Reply to Response to Motion</i> event was modified to <i>Reply Memorandum (Notice of No Reply) to Response to Motion</i> to provide the filer an option to have the docket text state that a reply memorandum is filed or a notice that no reply memorandum will be filed.

LR 7.1(d) Motions for Emergency Injunctive Relief	The <i>Motion For Preliminary Injunction</i> event was modified to provide the option for docket text, that expedited handling is required.
LR 7.1(f) Word or Line Limits; Certificate of Compliance	<p>Motion to Exceed the word/page limitation was modified to a new event, <i>Letter to Request Permission to Exceed Word/Line Limits</i>.</p> <p>New event, <i>Letter Response to Letter</i> created.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This event may only be used when it is related to a letter requesting permission to exceed the word/line limits or to file a motion to reconsider.
LR 7.1(j) Motion to Reconsider	<p>New event, <i>Letter to Request Permission to File Motion to Reconsider</i> was created to file a letter requesting permission to file a motion to reconsider and to respond under LR 7.1(j).</p> <p>New event, <i>Letter Response to Letter</i> created.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This event may only be used when it is related to a letter requesting permission to exceed the word/line limits or to file a motion to reconsider.
LR 37.1 Form of Discovery Motions	The <i>Certificate of Compliance with Local Rule 37.1</i> event was eliminated as it is no longer necessary.
