AMENDED ORDER APPOINTING RECEIVERS

On April 4, 2013, the Court entered an Order recusing the Receiver, R.J. Zayed, from the Zayed v. Associated Bank, No. 13-cv-0232, (DSD/JSM) action (the “Associated Bank Action”) and authorizing, solely for purposes of the Associated Bank Action, Tara Norgard, Brian Hayes, and Russell Rigby to collectively act on his behalf and in his capacity as Receiver, with all the powers appertaining thereto as set forth in the Court’s orders appointing the Receiver. (*SEC v. Cook*, et. al., 09-cv-3333, Dkts. 13,18 and 68; *CFTC v. Cook*, et. al., 09-cv-3332, Dkts. 21 and 96; and *SEC v. Beckman*, et. al., 11-cv-574, Dkt. 10.)

The Court has now been advised that Russell Rigby will be moving from the District of Minnesota and the firm of Carlson Caspers, and withdrawing from this and the Associated Bank Action.

The Court, being fully advised in the premises, hereby ORDERS that:

1. Tara Norgard and Brian Hayes are hereby authorized solely for purposes of the Associated Bank Action to act on behalf of the Receiver and in his capacity as the Receiver, with all the powers appertaining thereto as set forth in the Court’s orders appointing the Receiver;
2. All other aspects of the Court’s April 4, 2013 Order remain in full force and effect.
