**ORDER**

The United States of America, by Frank J. Magill, Jr., Acting United States Attorney for the District of Minnesota, and LeeAnn K. Bell, Assistant United States Attorney, have moved the Court to approve United States Border Protection for participation in the U.S. District Court's Petty Offense Program via participation in the Central Violations Bureau ("CVB") program for processing petty offense violations and to adopt a Forfeiture of Collateral Schedule for the violation of rules and regulations enforced by United States Border Protection and located in Minnesota.


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED the United States Border Protection may participate in the U.S. District Court's Petty Offense Program via participation in the Central Violations Bureau ("CVB") program for processing petty offense violations.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Forfeiture of Collateral Schedule is hereby adopted and that any person charged with violating an offense listed in the attached Forfeiture of Collateral Schedule for the United States Border Protection may, in lieu of appearance, post collateral in the amount indicated


for the offense and consent to forfeiture of collateral or be required to appear for offenses as indicated in the Collateral Schedule.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order take effect at 12:01 a.m. on April 10, 2008.






