

## **INDIVIDUAL PACER ACCOUNTS REQUIRED FOR FILING – SECOND NOTICE**

The U.S. District Court for the District of Minnesota will be going live with CM/ECF Next Generation on **October 5, 2015**. On that date, attorneys will no longer be able to log in to their CM/ECF accounts as they currently do. Instead, attorneys will log in to CM/ECF through a Central Sign-On (PACER) to file documents.

### **1) ATTORNEYS WILL NEED TO OBTAIN THEIR OWN INDIVIDUAL PACER ACCOUNTS.**

To obtain a new PACER account or upgrade an existing PACER account, please visit [www.pacer.gov](http://www.pacer.gov). Shared PACER accounts will not be able to be used by filing attorneys once the court has upgraded.

### **2) ATTORNEYS WILL NEED TO KNOW THEIR CURRENT CM/ECF LOGIN AND PASSWORDS.**

If you do not know your login or password, please use the password reset feature from the CM/ECF login page at <https://ecf.mnd.uscourts.gov/cgi-bin/login.pl>.
