[Search for a Party](#)

Enter the party name as it appears in the case caption. Search the database several times before adding a new party. The party database is extensive. Try searching with and without punctuation. Asterisks are not necessary when searching for partial names. Searches are not case sensitive and can only be performed by last name or business name.

If filing a Notice of Removal, enter the party names from the Complaint.

Please do **NOT** enter parties in ALL CAPS.

If there are multiple parties with the same name, double click on the party name. Do **NOT** pick a party with address information.

Do **NOT** enter in address, phone, or email information for parties.

Use the party text to clarify the party name. e.g., a Minnesota Corporation, in their individual and official capacity, etc.

If you cannot find your party already in the database, you must create a new party.

Although several data entry boxes appear on the Party Information screen, only the following fields should be completed.

- Last/Business Name;
- First Name;
- Middle Name or initial (If applicable);
- Generation (If applicable);
- Title (If applicable);
- Role (Plaintiff or Defendant); and
- Party text (If Applicable)

Individual Parties

Type at least the first two letters of the party's last name and first name in the corresponding fields and click **Search**. If you find your party's name already in the database, select that party. If you have descriptive information for a party as reflected in the case caption, enter the description in the party text field.

“Doe” Parties

If the actual identity of a party is unknown, they may be sued as a “Doe” party. In these instances, please search for the parties as follows:

Caption Name: **John Does 1-100**
Last Name: Does
First Name: John
Party Text: 1-100

If you have descriptive information for a party as reflected in the case caption, enter the description in the party text field, e.g. A Minnesota Corporation.

Proceed to the party information screen on page 9.

Business

Type the first two letters of the business name in the **Last/Business Name** field and click **Search**. Omit articles such as A, An, and The. Do not use First Name or Middle Name fields. You may abbreviate common words such as Company (Co) Corporation (Corp) Incorporated (Inc) if listed this way in the case caption. If you have descriptive information for a party as reflected in the case caption, enter the description in the party text field.

Cities/Towns/States

Enter the name of the city, town or state, in the **Last/Business Name** field and click **Search**. If “City of” is listed preceding the city or town do not include it in your search criteria.

Proceed to the party information screen on page 9.

United States of America

Enter “USA” or United States of America in the **Last/Business Name** field and click **Search**. Select the applicable party to mirror what is listed in the case caption.

Agencies

Enter only the agency name in the Last name field and click **Search**.

Social Security Cases

Enter the parties as they are captioned in the initiating document.

Estates

When entering estates, enter the executor/personal representative as the main party.

- Do not enter the deceased as a party.
- Enter them in the party text

Caption Name: Donna Happy as Personal Representative of the Estate of Jane Anderson
Last Name: Happy
First Name: Donna
Party Text: as Personal Representative of the Estate of Jane Anderson

Caption Name: The Estate of John McNeely
Last Name: Estate of John McNeely, The

Party Information Screen

Role

The **Role** type defaults to **defendant**. **Important, modify this field to the correct party role from the drop down list.**

Party Text

The **Party text** field is optional and may be used to add descriptive information about the party as it appears in the caption of the case initiating document.

Case Participant Tree

The information in the left side panel is referred to as the **Case Participant Tree**. The following chart provides a description of the icons and functions available.


Icon	Description
	Delete this party or alias from the case.
	Add a new alias in the case.
	Edit this party or alias in the case.
+ or -	Expands or collapses the party menu.

The **Expand All** hyperlink displays all party information in the case, including aliases. The **Collapse All** hyperlink displays only the names of the parties in the case, with all other information collapsed in the tree. Each branch of the case participant tree may be expanded or collapsed individually by clicking on the + and – icons.

Alias Type

Alias information may be added by selecting the **alias icon**. 

Select the appropriate alias **Type**. Click **Add Alias**.

Corporate Parent or Other Affiliate

Never enter a corporate parent or other affiliate for a party. Instead, file a Rule 7.1 Disclosure Statement after filing the initiating document.

After entering all parties in the case, expand the Case Participant Tree to review the party names for accuracy. If necessary, click the appropriate icon in the **Case Participant Tree** to add or correct information.

Create Case

When all parties have been added and appear correctly in the Case Participant Tree, click **Create Case**.
