

Opposing Counsel is Not Serving Me With Their Documents - posted April 12, 2004

**They should be.** ECF is currently internal only, meaning only court-generated documents are being posted on-line. Attorney-generated documents are still received in paper by the clerk's office and are not electronically attached to the docket. They are merely docketed (the same way they always have been) onto the record. When you receive an e-mail notification of an attorney-generated document, it is only an indication that this item has been docketed. The document number will not be a hyperlink as there is no electronic document available.

This will all change on **May 17**, when attorneys will be able to file electronically on ECF. In doing so, they are serving the others parties *who are registered participants of ECF*. Those who are not on ECF will still need to be served conventionally. From May 17 forward, all documents in ECF will have hyperlinks (attorney and court-generated) that take you directly to the actual document.
