

Some Documents Have Hyperlinks, and Others Do Not. Why?

1. Until the Court goes live externally in May, only court documents are available electronically (i.e., orders, judgments, court notices), so only e-notices of these filings will have the document number as a hyperlink which you can click on to get your "free peek" of the document. Filings by attorneys/parties will NOT be available electronically until May and the document number at this time will NOT be a hyperlink.
2. The case number will always be a hyperlink and will always try to run a docket sheet. Viewing a docket sheet is never free, so you will first be prompted for your ECF login and password, then, after clicking on "run report" you will be prompted for your PACER login and password so that they can bill you 7 cents per page with a \$2.10 max per document. Do not click on the case number for your free peek; it will not work and it will "use up" the free peek.
