**ORDER DENYING PLAINTIFF'S
MOTION TO ALLOW CASE
SPECIFIC DISCOVERY**

Plaintiff Margarete A. Dipietro, through counsel, filed a Motion to Allow Case Specific Discovery (MDL No. 13-2441 (DWF/BRT), Doc. No. 1247; Civil No. 18-1448 (DWF/BRT)¹) on April 23, 2019. The Court entered an Order on May 31, 2019 (MDL No. 13-2441 (DWF/BRT), Doc. No. 1293) directing lead counsel to meet and confer regarding a proposed Order for Supplemental Registration for the purpose of updating and managing the current docket in light of the settlements that have been reached in a large number of cases. Based upon the Court's Order of May 31, 2019, and the Court's decision at this time to request a status report with or without a proposed Order for
