**IN RE: ENTRANCE PROTOCOL
IN RESPONSE TO COVID-19**

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

The U.S. Marshals and Court Security Officers (CSOs) must restrict the following from entering the U.S. Courthouse:

1. Anyone who has traveled to any of the following countries within the last 14 days: China, Italy, Iran, South Korea, Europe (Schengen Area): Austria, Belgium, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Italy, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Monaco, San Marino, Vatican City, and United Kingdom and Ireland: England, Scotland, Wales, Northern Ireland, Republic of Ireland;
2. Anyone who resides or has had close contact with someone who has traveled to the following countries within the last 14 days: China, Italy, Iran, South Korea, Europe (Schengen Area): Austria, Belgium, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Italy, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Monaco, San Marino, Vatican City, and United Kingdom and Ireland: England, Scotland, Wales, Northern Ireland, Republic of Ireland;
3. Anyone who has been asked to self-quarantine by any hospital or health agency; or
4. Anyone who has been diagnosed with or has had contact with anyone who has been diagnosed with COVID-19.

Any visitor who meets the restricted categories above must inform the CSOs upon entering the courthouse.

Any attorney who meets the restricted categories above and who is scheduled to appear before the Court in the near future must notify the presiding judge of the

case so that appropriate safeguards can be taken. Attorneys may appear via teleconference or videoconference, with the approval of the presiding judge.

This order shall be effective as of March 17, 2020 and will remain in effect until further notice.
