**PRETRIAL ORDER NO. 25
(*RE: Motion for Leave to Withdraw
from Court-Appointed State
Court/MDL Liaison Counsel Position*)**

This matter is before the Court on State Court/MDL Liaison Counsel Matthew J. Sill's motion for leave to withdraw from his position. (Doc. No. 495.) Mr. Sill is one of two attorneys in that position. (Doc. No. 477 at 6.) The motion did not include a proposal for an attorney to replace Mr. Sill. Based on the foregoing and the record in this case, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that:

1. The motion for leave to withdraw from the court-appointed State Court/MDL Liaison Counsel position (Doc. No. [495]) is **GRANTED**. Matthew J. Sill is relieved of his Court-appointed leadership position as State Court/MDL Liaison Counsel in this multidistrict litigation effective immediately.

2. The remaining State Court/MDL Liaison Counsel and MDL Liaison Counsel shall submit a letter to the Court (1) summarizing the work of the State Court/MDL Liaison Counsels to date, and (2) a recommendation as to whether Mr. Sill's role should be replaced, and, if so, a recommendation as to who should fill that role.

3. Nothing in this Order relieves the attorney of any continuing obligations under prior Orders of this Court, including any Common Benefit Fee Orders, confidentiality obligations, or record-preservation requirements.
