**ORDER** 

In further management of its docket, on May 13, 2025, the Court entered an order issuing final notice to unrevised, settlement program ineligible Plaintiff Jose L. Nuncio in the above captioned, *Jose L. Nuncio v. Howmedica Osteonics Corp., d/b/a Stryker Orthopaedics, Stryker Corp., Stryker Sales Corporation and Stryker Ireland Limited* matter (MDL No. 13-2441 (DWF/DJF), (Doc. No. [2326]); Civil No. 14-1763 (DWF/DJF), (Doc. No. [10])). The order required a response from the Plaintiff Court within 14 days, or no later than May 27, 2025. - 2. The above captioned Jose L. Nuncio v. Howmedica Osteonics Corp., d/b/a Stryker Orthopaedics, Stryker Corp., Stryker Sales Corporation and Stryker Ireland Limited matter is hereby **DISMISSED** in its entirety **WITH PREJUDICE**.
