4. Administrative Deposition Subpoena
5. Application to Perpetuate Testimony (Fed. R. Civ. P. 27)
6. Application for Turnover Order
7. Receiverships (28 U.S.C. § 754)
8. Letters Rogatory or Letters of Request (28 U.S.C. §§ 1608, 1781-84; Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(i), 28(b))
9. Registration of Judgments (28 U.S.C. § 1963)
10. Warrant for Arrest of Juror (28 U.S.C. § 1866(g))
11. Pen Registers (28 U.S.C. § 1651(a))
12. Requests for Wire Interceptions (18 U.S.C. § 2516)
13. Requests for Video Interceptions (28 U.S.C. § 1651, Fed. R. Crim. P. 41(b))
14. Grand Jury Matters (Fed. R. Crim. P. 6(e)(2))
15. Internal Revenue Service Third Party Record Keeper Actions (28 U.S.C. § 7609)
16. Proceedings against Sureties (Fed. R. Civ. P. 65.1)
17. Requests from restricted filers to initiate new civil actions.

The Clerk is instructed to waive the miscellaneous case filing fee to open any miscellaneous case to process requests from restricted filers to initiate a new civil action.

This order supersedes and vacates all prior orders concerning the filing of miscellaneous cases and shall be effective July 1, 2018.
