ORDER

In further management of its docket, on April 16, 2025 the Court entered an order issuing final notice to unrevised, settlement program ineligible Plaintiff, Margaret Lang, in the above captioned matter, *Margaret Lang v. Howmedica Osteonics Corp., d/b/a Stryker Orthopaedics, Stryker Corp., Stryker Sales Corporation and Stryker Ireland Limited* (MDL No. 13-2441 (DWF/DJF) (Doc. No. 2321); Civil No. 14-2315 (DWF/DJF) (Doc. No. 7)). The order required a response from the Plaintiff within 14 days, or no later than April 30, 2025. The Court further noted that if no response from the Plaintiff was received by the Court by the deadline, then current counsel would be permitted to withdraw and the matter would be dismissed with prejudice, without further notice. ORDERED that:

- 1. Current counsel for Plaintiff Margaret Lang is permitted to withdraw.
- 2. The above captioned matter, *Margaret Lang v. Howmedica Osteonics*

Corp., d/b/a Stryker Orthopaedics, Stryker Corp., Stryker Sales Corporation and Stryker

Ireland Limited, is **DISMISSED** in its entirety **WITH PREJUDICE**.
