Counsel for plaintiffs and defendants have conferred as directed by PTO 99. Defendants will conduct a review of documents produced to date in accordance with PTO 99. Plaintiffs and defendants have agreed that a target date for completion of the review will be April 30, 2004. Plaintiffs and defendants will confer by February 28, 2004 on the progress of this project to determine whether any modifications should be made to this Order.

Defendants will produce new electronic images of documents that were originally designated as Confidential and which are de-designated as a result of this project. Production will be on a rolling basis. The new images will have the Confidential stamp removed. The new images will retain their original production "Bates" numbers except that defendants will add a suffix to the production number or some other appropriate stamp on the document to signify that the image is of a previously produced document that has been de-designated from Confidential. Defendants will identify by production "Bates" number or other reasonable means those documents for which defendants maintain a claim of confidentiality. Questions or disputes concerning the designation of a document as confidential shall be addressed through the process provided in Paragraph 9 of PTO 99.
