

This matter is before the Court upon Defendants' request to file a motion for reconsideration. The proper role of a motion to reconsider is extremely limited: "to correct manifest errors of law or to present newly discovered evidence." Hagerman v. Yukon Energy Corp., 839 F.2d 407, 414 (8th Cir.) cert. denied, 488 U.S. 820 (1988)); see also Rule 59(e), Fed. R. Civ. P. This Court has reviewed Defendants' submission, and finds no manifest error of law in its previous ruling.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Defendants' request to file a motion for reconsideration is DENIED.
